4. Ticket validity periods

- 4.1. A one-way ticket for travelling along the line zones is valid within the line or lines and zones indicated in the ticket within the following periods:
 - 4.1.1. one-way (**outward**) ticket is valid:
 - 4.1.1.1. at the date of purchase of the ticket **from** the time of issuing the ticket until 24.00;
 - 4.1.1.2. a ticket purchased after 21.00 from the date and time of issuing the ticket until 4.00 o'clock of the next day;
 - 4.1.1.3. a ticket purchased with a different date from 00.00 to 24.00 on the date indicated on the ticker;
 - 4.1.2. two-way ticket (**round trip**) is valid:
 - 4.1.2.1. for the **outward** trip in accordance with Clause 4.1.1;
 - 4.1.2.2. **return** ticket on the day of purchase of the outward ticket or the next day.
- 4.2. A one-way ticket, if one of the stops is outside the zone's tariff operation, is valid for the time and date indicated on the ticket within the following periods:
 - 4.2.1. a one-way **outward** ticket is valid for the time and date indicated on the ticket;
 - 4.2.2. a **return** ticket (separately executed) is valid for the time and date indicated on the ticket;
- 4.3. Validity periods for electronically purchased tickets, as well as the terms and conditions for the purchase, use and return of electronic tickets are available at www.pv.lv.
- 4.4. Subscription and day tickets are valid for the lines and zones indicated, and passengers may use them only during the validity period indicated on the ticket.
- 4.5. If a domestic passenger train is unable to continue the journey due to technical damage or other reasons, the ticket sold to the passenger is valid without extra charge in other domestic passenger trains going towards the same destination station.
